- Irrigation in Afghanistan**
 - Large water irrigation channels (*Kharezes*) have been constructed in drought stricken Afghanistan to facilitate the growing of crops.
 - Rehabilitation of Dam in wardak province providing electricity to thousands of homes
- 4 Water Tanks in Sudan**
 - Community Water Storage Tanks, each serving thousands of people, have been constructed in Western Sudan. Previously water had to be fetched from a distance of up to 40Km!
- Riverbank Enforcement**
 - The River Kabul on the outskirts of Peshawar regularly bursts its banks, washing away the mud huts that are home to 10,000 Afghan refugees at Haji-Zai Refugee Camp. MH has reinforced the river bank to protect the refugee population
