Last year we launched the extremely popular It's My Project Scheme. The concept is quite simple - you the donor fund your very own project. The project is done in the name of your choice, and a plaque commemorates this on site. We will of course provide you with the individual feedback of the work.

'It's My Project'



Islamabad School of excellence: A single businessman donor from Manchester has funded a superb quality school, on par with the best private institutions, BUT FOR ORPHANS. He was involved with the project from design to completion and present at the opening ceremony too. MH will continue to run and maintain the school. This school costs over £100,000.

Agriculture in The Gambia: Following a visit to The Gambia, one donor saw the need to help local women's groups earn a living through horticultural gardens. Through MHIMP, two farming plots costing only £2000 have been purchased and the project is now underway.

Islamic Societies: The London School of Economics and many other university students unions raise funds on a weekly basis at Juma prayer. LSE has worked closely with MHIMP to help different projects each week, each costing £250 - £400. Recent projects have included cleft lip correction surgery for a girl in China, wheelchairs in Iraq and tools for African farmers.

Emergency ambulance in Kashmir: Originally from Kashmir, a donor wanted to help his village and surrounding areas by providing a much needed ambulance. Through MHIMP he sponsored the cost of a complete ambulance which is now running on a self-

sustaining basis. Two wheeled drive ambulances cost £4500 and four wheel drive cost £9000

Youth Groups and classes: Many schools and youth groups have initiated aid projects through MHIMP: From termite infestation treatment in an orphanage in Iraq to rehabilitating a women's shelter and nursery in Baghdad. The children identified their own locations and projects. One UK school even sent over 100 'shoe box' gifts to orphans in Pakistan.

Equipment for schools: Many schools in the developing world struggle to get by without basic equipment. Many need libraries, science equipment, computers, and water coolers...the list goes on. From £300 to £700, many donors have helped with small grants for Schools, funding science labs, libraries and IT equipment to name but a few.
