Make **ALL** your donations 28% bigger

If you live in the UK

and usually pay tax, the Government allows us to claim it back on your donation, if you have made a Gift Aid Declaration.

Example: If you donate £100
Tax from Gift Aid is ~£28
Total donation now is £128

You only need to do this once - ALL your donations to MH can then be treated as Gift Aid donations. However, do tell us if you cease to be a UK tax payer.
