Orphan Sponsorship



Ten years ago, MH launched our Orphan Sponsorship Scheme. Its simplicity was the root of its success: one donor provides education and welfare to an orphaned child as long as the child remains at school. Orphan workers ensured the orphans received a sound education and kept donors informed of the orphan's progress.

Many of the orphans who passed through the scheme either continued on to further education or training, whilst others went straight into employment.

Ten years on there are over **4600** orphans in **22** of the world's poorest countries going to school because MH donors agree that through the provision of a sound education we can give the poor the opportunity to help themselves out of poverty.

In 2000 MH embarked on a long term school building programme designed to further raise the standard of education received by MH orphans. We have now established over 120 schools from Kosovo to Kashmir, Sudan to Sri Lanka. Of course our schools allow poor children who are not orphans to attend through MH Student Sponsorship, but orphans are given priority.

Callers to our office often ask which is the best way of spending their charity, the answer is

‘Sponsor a poor orphan child today’
